V&A (Victoria and Albert Museum)
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The Victoria and Albert Museum, London is the world’s greatest museum of art and design. It has millions of amazing artefacts, including world class collections of glass, textiles, graphics, photography, jewellery and fashion.

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V&A Textile Collections

The V&A national collection of textiles covers a period of more than 2000 years. It includes woven, printed and embroidered textiles, lace, tapestries and carpets with a broad geographic range and a particular emphasis on Europe. Other rich areas are early silks from the Near East, lace and European tapestries.



V&A Fashion and Costume Collections

The V&A costume collections feature fashionable dress, accessories, including shoes, handbags and gloves from the major fashion centres of Europe.



V&A Jewellery Collections

The V&A has one of the finest and most comprehensive jewellery collections in the world. More than 16,000 pieces with historical importance, from Byzantium, through to some of the finest designs from the great jewellery houses of the 20th century as well as by important contemporary makers.



V&A National Collection of Wallpapers

The V&A has one of the finest collections of wallpapers in the world. It holds the national collection of historic wallpapers from late 15th century to contemporary, with examples from across the globe. It includes wallpaper samples, original designs, advertising material and illustrations of interiors, pattern books and order books.



V&A Photographic Archives

The V&A photographic archive is now one of the world’s largest and most important collections, holding over 500,000 images, by both classic and contemporary photographers.
